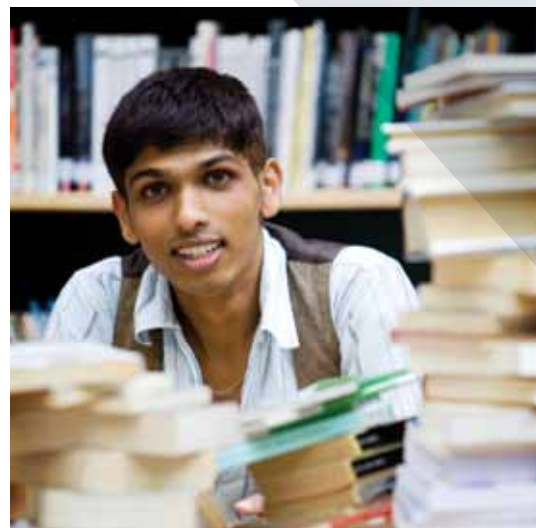

Fees

The fee is \$1,896.00. An annual PSA Intern membership may be included in the payment plan at a cost of \$165.00. The payment plan choices are:

1. A single payment; of \$2061.00 including membership or \$1896.00 for the course only.
2. Four installments of \$515.25 including membership or \$474.00 for course fee only.
3. Eight monthly installments of \$257.65 including membership or \$237.00 for the course fee only.
