By providing a nomination form, candidates consent to the use of their individual candidate information and photo as stated.

#### Excerpt from PSA By-Law 9.3 and 11.1

- 9.3 The Branch Committee shall be elected by the members who are eligible to vote, in accordance with By-Law 11.
- 11.1 The following categories of members are **not eligible** to stand for election to the Branch Committee:
  - a. Associate Members;
  - b. Student Members;
  - c. Affiliate Members;
  - d. International Members;
  - e. Incorporated Members; and
  - f. Honorary Members and honorary fellows, who are not pharmacists.
