Candidate successfully completes MCQ. Completes Case Study No. 1 and submits within 60 day submission period to marker

Candidate notified by the accreditation manager via email, and second HMR case study is released with a 60 day submission period

Marker assesses the second HMR case study as a 'pass'.

Candidate notified by the accreditation manager via email, and first RMMR case study is released with a 60 day submission period

Marker assesses the first RMMR case study as a 'pass'.

Candidate notified by the accreditation manager via email, the second RMMR case study is released with a 60 day submission period

Marker assesses the second RMMR case study as a 'pass'.

Candidate notified by the accreditation manager via email, and the 'offer of accreditation' is made

Marker assesses the initial case as 'NYC'. Candidate notified by accreditation manager with a 21 day resubmission period

Marker assesses the resubmitted case as NYC.

Accreditation manager notifies candidate that cases have been referred to the CEO for review and decision

CEO decision based on PSA policy. 'New' case study is released for completion with a 60 day submission period.

Marker assesses new case as a 'pass'. Candidate moves on to second HMR case study

Marker assesses new case as **NYC**. Candidate notified by accreditation manager with a 21 day resubmission period

Marker assesses new case as a 'pass'. Candidate moves on to second HMR case study

Marker assesses the resubmitted case as **NYC**. Accreditation manager notifies candidate that cases have been referred to the CEO for review and decision
