- 1. Entry is only open to PSA Members, and employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter are ineligible to enter.
- 2. Winners' names will be published on www.psa.org.au, and the PSA Social media channels. Each entrant consents, if the entrant becomes a Winner, to the Promoter using the entrant's name, in any media for an unlimited period of time without remuneration for the purpose of promoting this promotion (including any outcome), the Promoter and/or products/services supplied by the Promoter.
- 3. Prizes are to be used for pharmacy educational purposes, and will be administered by the PSA.
- 4. Travel (when included in the prize) will be via the most direct route, economy class.
- 5. Unless otherwise stipulated, no prize, or any unused portion of a prize, is transferable, exchangeable or redeemable for cash. Prize money must be used within 24 months.
