## Nominations are now open for the elevation of members to Fellow of the Pharmaceutical Society of Australia.

Ordinary members of the Society may be nominated for elevation to Fellow of the Society if they have served the Society for an extended period of time, and who have, by working in the profession:

- achieved a significant advancement in the practice of pharmacy or pharmaceutical sciences; OR
- provided an outstanding contribution to the pharmacy profession through leadership; OR
- significantly contributed to raising professional standards and providing models for other pharmacists.

For the purposes of the above criteria, an extended period is defined as a minimum of 10 years. Nominations for elevation to Fellow will be considered for individuals who have been Ordinary members of the Society for a minimum of 10 years, or at the discretion of the PSA Board.

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Newly elevated Fellows will be recognised at the PSA Fellow Dinner in Sydney on Friday 31 July 2026. More details to come.
